JESUS CHRIST, OUR SAVIOUR

Since Creation, God showed his love by creating man in his image and likeness, and gave him a place in Eden (Gen 1: 26-28).

However, under Satan's influence, man followed another path, that of disobedience to the order given. This disobedience spread to future generations where humans gave themselves up to their heart's inclination, specially the indulgence of the flesh.

For Adam and Eve, it is seduction by the forbidden fruit that took them away from the face of God and they lost their dignity (Gen 3:4-24).

During the first multiplications of men on earth, the sons of God took the daughters of humans as wives, and all the thoughts of their hearts went each day towards evil. The Lord did not like this and decided to destroy all living creatures starting with man up to the cattle. Some of them survived, thanks to Noah who was found righteous and blameless before God (Gen 6:1-22).

Further in time, there was a generation when men went to false Gods, false prophecies, false dreams and false teachings, due to the misguidance of some people and the death of several others (Judges2: 1-21; 1Kgs 18:18-40; Jr 23:32).

In another generation men took part in drunkenness, debauchery, prostitution, in short in pleasure, which led several people to death (1Co 10:6-12). Among them were priests and prophets who took strong drinks (Isaiah 28: 7-8). Were saved only those who found grace before God.

This generation is not spared. It is the worst generation where you find all that has been said previously, plus occultism, rebellion, treason, love of pleasure more than of God, relations against nature of man with man, woman with woman and man with animal (2 Tm 3: 1-5; Rm 1 :25-31).

Some gave themselves to the love of money, not knowing that the love of money is the root of all evil.

How many people, although rich, but due to the inclination of their hearts engaged in excesses (such as incest, debauchery, insults and adultery) which plunged their families into malediction and darkness (1 Tm 6:10).

The poor blinded by the devil, think they will come out of poverty through stealing, prostitution, sorcery, occultism, but they are overcome by catastrophes, incurable diseases and sudden death. Several have regretted a few hours before their death their

life shortened by sin and the useless pacts, they signed with the father of lies. (Luke 13: 1-5).

In spite of all that, God did not abandon mankind. He sent his only son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to help them return to his vision, so that what is good and laudable be always in their thoughts and that they relinquish the desires of the flesh that are only vanity (John 3:16; Ph 4: 7-8).

The solution to sin is in Jesus Christ. He shed his blood once and for all as the price for our sins. Come back to him and repent from all your sins, and He will welcome you. All those who come back to Christ with their whole heart will receive the Holy Spirit from God and become good administrators of the various graces of God (Rev 1 :5); Eph 2:13; 1 Cor 12:1-11); 1 Peter 4 :10).

Who can by himself live in truth, justice, righteousness and the love of one's neighbour?

It is through the Holy Spirit that man becomes God-like. Henceforth the thought of mutual peace, unity and the joy to be together will be in him. He understands that he does not live for himself, therefore the loss or error of his neighbour is not in his thought anymore like Jesus Christ who said:" ...I guarded those you gave me, and none of them perished ..." (John 17: 12). He becomes a way out for his family as Noah and others.

We beg you to believe in the Lord Jesus Christ so that you receive from God, first the remission of your sins, and then the Holy Spirit who will guide you every day in the truth.

Thus, bad things, deceptions, humiliations and scandals experienced will not influence your character anymore, because these things will be erased from your thoughts by the Holy Spirit who will guide you so that your behaviour and your life are the reflection of the Word of God.

Like Jesus Christ anointed with the Holy Spirit, evil did not influence his character from his arrest to his death on the cross, likewise by the same Spirit, you will overcome evil through good (1 Th 5: 23; Rom 12:20-21).

Besides, know that on judgement day, any person will only be saved through Jesus Christ, as he said in John 5: 24: "Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life".
